Entries are now being accepted for the Glenbervie School 4WD 'tag along' Safari the inaugural event organised by Glenbervie School and the Whangarei 4WD Club. The Safari commences with scrutineering at 8.30am on Saturday morning at Glenbervie Forest HQ, Maruata Road, Glenbervie.

Scenic Safari: This is a one day tag along event suitable for all road legal, low range 4WD vehicles (club) and, at the discretion of the organisers, late model high clearance SUVs with EBS and traction control (shiny). The trail meanders through Rayonier New Zealand Glenbervie Forest and adjoining farms. These venues are normally inaccessible to the public and this Safari will provide you with a unique opportunity to traverse the countryside and experience magnificent views of native bush, forest, farmland and the coast. This promises to be great day out for individuals and families, with track options from easy going to more challenging. Each group of vehicles will be supported by guides from the Whangarei 4WD Club.

The event will be run in two classes:

- **Shiny class:**
 - all vehicles on HT (road tread) tyres
 - all high clearance vehicles without low ratio. (at the discretion of the organisers)
- **Club Class:**
 - standard 4WD vehicles with low ratio and AT (all terrain) tyres or better. A few bush marks possible.

Scrutineering:

The following provides vehicle specifications and/or requirements:

Open to all road legal, low range 4WD vehicles (club) and late model high clearance SUVs with EBS and traction control (shiny). Check with us if you are uncertain about your vehicle's suitability.

Compulsory
Full tank of gas
Basic vehicle tool kit
Spare wheel & changing equipment

Recommended
First aid kit & medication
Fire extinguisher

Tyres - Please note. Road type tread patterns with good tread depth (50% minimum) are acceptable. Ordinary road tyres may cause problems in tricky situations and vehicles with these type of tyres may be limited to some sections if weather is wet. All vehicles will be scrutineered prior to participation and all aspects of the checklist above will be adhered to so we can ensure the safe and smooth passage of all people involved in this event.

Venue

The event scrutineering and starting point will be at Rayonier NZ Glenbervie Forest, Maruata Road, Glenbervie, Whangarei. From here the trails follow the forestry roads and at different intervals enter adjoining farmlands before returning to the forest. Costs

The cost is \$90 per vehicle including the driver. Additional adults \$12.00 per person; children under 15 years \$8.00 per person. This fee provides morning tea, lunch, and full access to forest and farms.

Cut-Off for entries

The final date for the receipt of postal entries will be Wednesday, 25th April 2012. Limited 'on the day' admissions. Your entry including your cheque for your group's costs should be posted to arrive by that date.

General

Further information will be forwarded to registrants and those expressing interest as it comes to hand. It is expected the Safari will start at 9.30am (after scrutineering) and be completed by 4.30pm.

Indemnity

You are required to read and sign the Indemnity form for public liability insurance purposes. This enables you to become a day member of the Whangarei 4WD Club. All drivers and any other passengers not under the legal guardianship of the driver must sign an Indemnity

Statement of Indemnity

IN CONSIDERATION of you the organisers accepting my application for participation on a run of the Whangarei Four Wheel Drive Club I HEREBY:

2. DECLARE that to the best of our belief we possess the standard of driving competence and medical fitness necessary to enable us to safely participate in the event for which access is being permitted.
3. AGREE to indemnify and save harmless and keep indemnified the organisers and their respective officials, officers, members, servants, representatives and agents and all the owners and tenants of private property traversed by this event from and against all losses, actions, proceedings, claims, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss or damage to persons or property of ourselves, our drivers and co-drivers, or passengers or of any other person whatsoever arising out of or in connection with this access or of us taking part in the event for which access is being permitted or the use of our vehicle in this event, whether authorised or not, notwithstanding that such death, injury, loss or damage may have been contributed to or caused by the negligence of the organisers or of any of their respective officials, officers, members, servants, representatives or agents or by any other person.
4. GIVE any necessary consent under the Privacy Act 1993 to the details contained on this form being held by the organisers for the purpose of the promotion and benefit of such access and four wheel driving in general and we acknowledge our right to access and correction of this information.
5. UNDERTAKE that the signatures on this form are the true signatures of the parties concerned and that each person who is likely to drive the vehicle in the event for which access is being permitted has signed this form.
